Speak Somali, Oromo, Amharic, or Swahili? Bilingual applicants are needed and are encouraged to apply.

The Census Bureau has waived the citizenship requirement to become a census worker based on language need. Noncitizens who are authorized to work in the U.S. will be considered for positions that require proficiency in a particular language if no qualified citizens are available. If selected for a position, noncitizens must present documentation of employment eligibility.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A 2020 CENSUS JOB, YOU MUST:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have a valid Social Security number.
- Be authorized to work in the U.S. *See note above regarding bilingual applicants.*
- Have a valid email address.
- Complete an application and answer assessment questions. (Some assessment questions are available in Spanish. However, an English proficiency test may also be required.)
- Be registered with the Selective Service System or have a qualifying exemption, if you are a male born after Dec. 31, 1959.
- Pass a Census-performed criminal background check and a review of criminal records, including fingerprinting.
- Commit to completing training.
- Be available to work flexible hours, which can include days, evenings, and/or weekends.
